THE BEST-KEPT SECRET AT HBC

Have you visited the church's library? Do you now where it is located? Well, it is closer than you might expect. Just off the sanctuary behind the folding wall is the church's library. The collection includes both fiction and non-fiction children's books, books for pre-teens, and books for adults as well as videotapes for all patrons.

The library is a bit old-fashioned, not yet automated. For those who remember checking out books before the computer age, you will enjoy the walk down memory lane. Items contain a card and pocket. Cards need to be signed by the person checking out and both the card and the date due slip must be stamped with the date for which the book is to be returned.

Library users do need to fill out a patron card. A family may fill out one card for the family or individual users need to fill in a card. Children need the signature of the parent if filling out a card alone. This is so we can mail an overdue notice or call if items are not returned on time. Cards can be found in the library.

Sunday School Teachers may check out whatever is needed for their teaching, but others are limited to 2 items per person. Videos should be checked out by adults, so children need to get their parents to check out videos for them. Items should be returned within two weeks of checkout.

Hours of operation are on Sundays between Sunday School and Church, 10:40 am—10:55 am. On days when the staff of one is on duty in the nursery or on vacation, the library is closed. Dependable volunteers in the library could extend the times of operation.

So, the best kept secret is now out in the open and we would love to have you come visit and maybe even volunteer.
